Still in foudre at the time of my visit, the 2014 Panoplie is mostly Mourvedre and is scheduled to be bottled in a few weeks. Notes of black plums, licorice, smoked herbs, flowers and caramelized cherries all emerge from this medium to full-bodied, rich, layered 2014 that has the house purity and elegance, as well as building tannin and a beautiful length. Give bottles a few years in the cellar and enjoy over the following decade.
