- California project of the Perrins of Château de Beaucastel and Robert Haas of Vineyard Brands.
- Tablas Creek's signature red wine is a traditional blend of Southern Rhône varietals:

40% Mourvèdre

28% Syrah

27% Grenache

5% Counoise

- Vines imported from the Beaucastel estate.
- Grown on limestone soils in the hilly Las Tablas district of west Paso Robles, chosen for its similarity to Châteauneuf-du-Pape.
- Organically farmed vineyard.
- All wines estate grown and bottled.
- Fermented in classic style using native yeasts.

A powerfully Rhône-like nose of red plum, currant and roasted meat, flavors of cassis, cherry, and mineral, and a long, rich finish with ripe tannins and red and black fruits.
